✓ Director happily informed about the successful completion of Convocation 2022 after more than 5.5 years. It was held on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 at 10:00 AM. The help of senators, BoG, FC and other faculty and staff are highly appreciated.

- The new students of Batch 2022-23 have arrived, and their programs are started as per academic calendar. Interacted with Students and Guardians on 5th Nov 2022.
- ✓ A branch-wise distribution of newly admitted students is as follows.
  - ➤ BCS= 76 (72/JoSSA+CSAB+4/DASA)
  - IMT= 120 (119/JoSSA+CSAB+1/DASA)
  - ➤ IMG= 69 (69/JoSSA+CSAB)
- ✓ In all, the students are from 22 states of India. However, the majority are from following
  - Uttar Pradesh = 48; Maharashtra = 36; Telangana = 35; Madhya Pradesh=33; Andhra Pradesh = 30; Rajasthan = 16; Haryana = 15; Bihar = 12
- ✓ End semester Examinations of all the students (except 1<sup>st</sup> year) are going on as per schedule.
- ✓ First Atal Research and Incubation Conclave (ARIV 2022) is planned during Dec 9-10, 2022.
- ✓ IEEE International Conference on Information and Communication Technology (CICT-2022) was successfully organized during November 18-20, 2022, at ABV-IIITM Gwalior. Prof. K. K. Agrawal, Chairman NBA was chief guest and Prof. M. M. Tripathi, Director General, NIELIT, New Delhi was Guest of honor.

IMG (B. Tech. + MBA) =69 (JoSSA+CSAB)

The Senate approved the proposal of the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering to start the new B. Tech. (4-years) program titled "Electrical and Electronics Engineering" with 40 students. However, owing to the problem of hostel accommodation, it would cut the intake of IMT and IMG students by 30 and 10, respectively.

Item 27.6	Department of Computer Science and Engineering plans to  (a) start a new M. Tech. course titled "Machine Learning and Data Engineering" and  (b) rename the existing M. Tech. course titled "Information Security" to "Cyber Security and Cyber Laws".

The Senate approved the eligibility criteria for admission to Master of Business Administration (MBA) program as proposed.

The Senate approved the eligibility criteria for Doctoral (PhD) program in Management as follows.

(A) M. Tech. /M. E. / M. D. or equivalent with 65% marks or 7.00 GPA on a 10-point scale with Mathematics/Statistics as one of the courses at UG level AND (B) a valid GATE score or equivalent for medicine

## OR

(A) M. Sc. / MBA /M. A. / MBBS or equivalent with 60% marks or 6.75 GPA on a on a 10-point scale with Mathematics/Statistics as one of the courses at UG level **AND** (B) a national level examination like CSIR / UGC NET or JRF / ICAR / ICMR / DST fellowship) or having valid CAT / GMAT / GRE score

## OR

(A) B. E. or B. Tech. equivalent with 75% marks or 8.0 GPA on a 10-point scale from CFTIAND (B) a valid GATE score

Item 27.9	Matter related to special cases of students  (a) Matter of reporting related to withdrawal and  (b) Delayed start of study of a student of 2020 batch with the students of 2022 batch

- (a) The approved withdrawal of Mr. Om Thorat (2022IMT-079) with effect from odd (Jul Dec) semester in the academic year 2022-23.
- (b) The Senate allowed Mr. Robin Singh (2020BCS-064) to start his studies from the first semester with the new batch of 2022.

Item 27.10	Award of B. Tech. Degree to a student of IMT/IPG if the student is in final semester, failed in many courses, and not willing to continue the study.

The Senate in principle approved the proposal to exit with only a B. Tech. Degree if credit requirements and relevant courses are completed for a B. Tech. degree. To insure this, chairman senate may form a committee to see it on the case-to-case basis.
