

Indeed the normal is often irrelevant.Almost everything in social life is produced by rare but consequential shocks and jumps; all the while almost everything studied about social life focuses on the "normal," particularly with "bell curve" methods of inference that tell you close to nothing. Why? Because the bell curve ignores large deviations, cannot handle them, yet makes us confident that we have tamed uncertainty. I call it, the Great Intellectual Fraud.

Bottom Line: I make a claim, that our world is dominated by the extreme and the very improbable-and all the while we spend our time engaged in small talk, focusing on the known, and the repeated. This implies not to treat extreme event as an exception to be pushed under the rug. What you don't know is far more relevant than what you do know.@

KNOW MORE ABOUT CLOUD

- The cloud computing market is projected to reach \$106 billion by 2017. This represents a 30% growth rate from 2013. This is especially stark when you take into account that the entire enterprise IT industry is only expected to experience a 5% growth rate between 2013 and 2018. Additionally, experts project that by 2018, 59% of all of the cloud's workload will be the result of Software-as-a-Service This represents a 41% increase since 2013.
- 80% of companies that adopt the cloud see improvements within their IT departments within six months. These improvements were generally in the areas of efficiency, quality and security. Additionally, moving to the cloud helped these companies save money, cut costs and use staff more efficiently. After adopting the cloud, upwards of 90% of IT decision makers saw marked improvements in at least one area of the IT department.
- Banking produces the most activity within the cloud.

This is due to the introduction of widespread mobile banking services in 2013. Additionally, the rise of crowdfunding services and money management services like PayPal have grown, driving the act of paying virtually for goods through the roof. With the rising popularity of virtual currencies like Bitcoin, this trend of cloud computing for banking is only projected to continue.



- At the census 2001, out of 1028 million population, little over 827 million (80.5%) have returned themselves as followers of Hindu religion, 138 million (13.4%) as Muslims or the followers of Islam, 24 million (2.3%) as Christians, 19 million (1.9%) as Sikh, 8 million (0.80%) as Buddhists and 4 million (0.4%) are Jain.





THE MYSTERIOUS WORLD OF QUANTUM COMPUTING!

In today's smart era, it is

beguiling that smartphones carry so much computing power equal to military computers fifty years ago which comprised an entire room. The evolution of technology has been phenomenal. We have seen a lot of transformations in the machine era from big size computers to desk PCs or laptops to hand-held devices like smartphones. Now everyone is powered with computing facility at his/her end. With all this evolution and transformations. today's problems have become more complex and dynamic and are thus difficult to solve using traditional systems or machines. To solve these problems, the most advanced technology of quantum computing is on the line! Quantum computing is a big revolutionary transition, from classical computers to the computers which are infinitely faster and can solve problems that would require unattainable amounts of computing power today.

If we look at numeric figures of data consumption, it is around 2.5 exabyte of data every day. With every minute of every day, the rising glorious number of 3.2 billion global internet users continue to feed the data banks with approximately 9,722 pins on Pinterest, 347,222 tweets and 4.2 million Facebook transactions. 

MIND BENDING FACTS ABOUT QUANTUM COMPUTING

- In a quantum state, particles can achieve something we call superposition, where they exist in multiple states simultaneously.
- A quantum computer could solve problems in a few minutes that would take a traditional computer roughly the lifetime of the universe.
- In a quantum state, two particles can enter a state of profound entanglement, remaining eerily connected to each other no matter how far apart they become.
- A quantum computer would run on quantum bits, or qubits. Unlike traditional bits, which are either a "1" or a "0," those clever qubits can act as a "1," a "0" or both, and have exponentially greater computing power.

Yes...


The wait was worth it.

हॉन्गकॉन्ग के पास समुद्र किनारे दीवार पर विशाल अक्षरों में लिखा है "नया युग नई क्रांति। मैं सपने देखने वाले दिलों का निर्माता हूँ।"

नवीनतम सर्वेक्षण के मुताबिक 2016 तक हान्गकॉन्ग में करीब 2,000 स्टार्टअप्स थे जिसमें 5,000 से ज्यादा कर्मचारी काम करते है। दिलचस्प बात यह है कि विदेशी

स्टार्टअप संस्थापकों का सबसे बड़ा प्रतिशत 20: यू.एस. से है।पिछले दो दशकों में, चीन मे उद्यमिता एक घातीय दर से बढ़ी है। यह न केवल चीन बल्कि दुनिया के बाकी हिस्सों के लिए भी बड़ा परिवर्तन ला रहा है।

सन् 2000 में चीनी राज्य के स्वामित्व वाली औदयोगिक उदयमों और गैर-सरकारी

स्वामित्व वाले चीनी निजी उद्यमों द्वारा अर्जित कुल राजस्व लगभग 4 ट्रिलियन 'युआन' समान था। 2013 तक एक सरकारी कंपनियों का कुल राजस्व जहाँ केवल छह गुना बढ़ा था। गैर राज्य क्षेत्र में राजस्व 18 गुना से अधिक बढ गया था। इसी अविध में मुनाफे में और अधिक उल्लेखनीय अंतर दिखा सरकारी स्वामित्व वाली कंपनियों में सात गुना बड़ोतरी हुई लेकिन गैर सरकारी स्वामित्व वाले व्यक्तियों के मुनाफे में करीब 23 गुना वृद्धि हुई।

अर्थव्यवस्था में मन्दी को बदलने की कोशिश में नवाचार और उद्यमशीलता पर सरकार का ध्यान भी नए पंजीकृत उद्यमों के उदय में सहायक रहा है।

कुछ साल पहले तक चीनी 'इनोवेशन' का मतलब था नकल और फर्जी चीजें। लेकिन अब प्रेरक शक्ति 'ड्रांइविंग फोर्स' है

'आंत्रप्रेन्योर्स' की साहसी प्रतिभाशाली और वैश्विक सोच रखने वाली पीढी निवेशक उन पर नजर बनाये हुए है। बर्ष 2014 से 2016के बीच लगभग 77 अरब डॉलर का 'कैपिटल' निवेश हुआ, जबिक 2011—13 में यह सिर्फ 12 अरब डॉलर ही था। चीन की 'यूनिकॉर्न' 350 अरब डोलर से ऊपर की कंपनी है जो अमेरिका के कुल वैल्यूएशन

के करीब है। नतीजा यह है कि जहाँ चीन में 609 अरबपित है वहीं अमेरिका में 552। चीनी 'आंत्रप्रेन्योर्स' के बिजनेस तेजी से बढने के दो कारण है —

पहला चीनी अर्थव्यवस्था इतनी बड़ी है कि यदि कंपनी घरेलू बाजार में ही सफल हो जाए तो बड़ा आकार ले सकती है। यूरोप की तुलना में चीन भाषा और संस्कृति में अधिक समान है और अमेरिका के विपरीत मूलभूत ढांचा जैसे सड़कें 'वायरलैस ब्रांडेड' नया और श्रेष्ठ है।

दूसरा, चीनी खरीददार नई चीजों का प्रयोग करने में झिझकते नहीं है। अच्छे प्रोडक्ट पर नए ब्रैंड वाली कंपनी को इसका फायदा मिलता है। नई 'टेक्नोलॉजी' को आजमाने के लिए भी वे असाधारण उत्सुकता दिखाते है। चीन बहुत तेजी से 'केशलेस' हो रहा है। चीन में जहाँ पिछले वर्ष मोबाइल पेमेंट चार गुना बढकर 8.6 खरब डोलर हो गया था, अमेरिका में यह 112 अरब डॉलर ही था। साहसी ग्राहक न सिर्फ नए प्रोडक्ट आजमाते

अमेरिका में यह 112 अरब डॉलर ही था। साहसी ग्राहक न सिर्फ नए प्रोडक्ट आजमाते है बिल्क यदि वे उत्कृष्ठ श्रेणी के नहीं भी हो तो पश्चिमी लोगों की तुलना में चीनी. अधिक क्षमाशील होते है। चीन में स्मार्टफोन मोबाइल पेमेन्ट और 'इन्टरनेट ऑफ थिंग्स' की विस्फोटक वृद्धि ने कई कंपनीयों को तेजी दी। 'कुआंग ची' समूह हीलियम से भरे गुब्बारों से कमाई कर रहा है। बहुत सारे सेंसर और संचार उपकरणों से लैस ये गुब्बा. रे शहरों के बहुत ऊपर टंगे रहते है। इसके चेयरमैन रोपेंग लिऊ का मानना है कि स्मार्ट शहरों के लिय यह सस्ता उपग्रह है। यह ट्रेफिक, प्रदूषण पर निगरानी रखने के अलावा 'इन्टरनेट ऑफ थिंग्स' के लिए हब का काम कर सकता है।

फंडिंग की जिम्मेदारी पहले बड़ी संस्थाओं जैसे होराइजन्स वेंचर्स पर होती थी। अब इसमें मंथवर्क वेंचर्स और वैक्टर वेंचर्स जैसी उभरती संस्थाए भी शामिल हो रही है। इसके अलावा अलीबाबा जैसे बड़े चीनी निगम भी हाल ही में स्थानीय स्टार्टअप में सक्रिय रूप से निवेश कर रहे हैं। इन्टरनेट उद्यमियों ने 1990 के मध्य में उभरना शुरू कर दिया था। समकालीन दिगज्जों जैसे 'अलीबाबा, टेनेंट और बैडु' का भी तभी गठन हुआ था। 2000 के दशक में उद्यमियों की संख्या फिर से बढी। 'ज़ियामी, जेडीकॉम और क्यूह 360' के

संथापक चीन के इन्टरनेट उद्यमियों के प्रमुख उदाहरण है जो इस अवधि के दौरान उठे थे। इन्टरनेट और मोबाइल प्रौद्योगिकी क्षेत्रों के अलावा, कई उद्यमियों ने अन्य उद्ययोगों जैसे ऊर्जा, स्वास्थ्य देखभाल, वित्तीय सेवाओं, उपभोक्ता, खुदरा क्षेत्र आदि में भी रुचि दिखना कर दिया।

आज चीन में 1980 और 1990 के दशक में पैदा होने वाले कई युवक है जो उद्यमी आकांक्षाएं रखते है। निस्संदेह एक निष्पक्ष संख्या या शायद उनमें से अधिकांश अपने पहले प्रयास मे सफल नही होंगे, लेकिन चीन बड़ा है और बड़ें आधार का एक छोटा प्रतिशत भी अभी एक महत्वपूर्ण संख्या है। अपने पूर्वजों के विपरीत, ये युवा विफलता से डरते नही है। उनके लिए 'ट्रायल एंड एरर' प्रक्रिया का एक अनिवार्य हिस्सा है। अंत में चाहे वह सफल हो या न हो, उनके अनुभव बढ़ते है और भविष्य के लिए नए अवसर खुलते है। भारत इस दौड में बहुत पीछे नहीं है। व्यक्तिगत गति पर होगा। देशों की सरकार की स्थापना बहुत भिन्न है। चीन में सरकार एक बड़े समाजिक बदलाव के लिए उद्यमियों को मिलाने की कोशिश कर रही है। यहाँ आपके पास बहुत उद्यमीशीलता है, पैसे बनाने के कई महान विचार है, लेकिन जो गायब है, वो ये विचार कि कैसे प्रौद्योगि. की भारत के सामाजिक – आर्थिक विकास का मूलभूत हिस्सा हो सकता है। चीन की तुलना में भारत में अधिक उद्यमी है लेकिन वे अलग-अलग कंपनियों के विकास की दिशा में कड़ी मेहनत कर रहे है। विकास अंततः होगा लेकिन यह समन्वित प्रयास नही

INDUSTRY PROFILE: STEVE JOBS (APPLE'S GENIUS)

-Steve Jobs (February 24,1955 - Octover 5,2011) was co-founder, chairman and CEO of Apple Inc. His impact on the technology industry, entertainment, advertising and pop culture was vast and he leaves behind an empire that is changing the way we all live and work.

-It all started with three men - Steve Jobs, Steve Wozniak and Mike Markkula - who together in the late 1970's designed and marketed the Apple II series of computers. It was the first commercially successful line of personal computers and led to the Apple Lisa in 1983 - the first computer to use a mouse-driven GUI (graphical user interface).

-In 2010, after many variations of the iPhone, the iPad was launched to an initially mediocre reception. People and focus groups didn't see the need for it, but Steve Jobs knew it was going to have a big impact. And it did. By March of 2011, over 15 million iPads were in the market.

-The health of Steve Jobs had been in question since around 2006, when his gaunt, frail appearance and lackluster delivery were the focus of his WWDC keynote address. Between 2003 and his death in August 2011, Jobs underwent many procedures and therapies to try and beat the cancer, but it was too aggressive. He stepped down as CEO of Apple on August 24 th, 2011, and died just a few weeks later on September 11th.
