Condition Page 2 Para 3

The applicants must have a minimum of two (02) years of experience in relevant area along with the **discipline specific criteria**. However, the minimum PG qualification would be relaxed to UG qualification (only for B.E/B.Tech background) for persons working with the industry and having a minimum of five (05) years of relevant experience. Moreover, while applying, the candidate has to take NOC from the current organization.

Condition Revised as Page No-2 Para 3

The applicants must have a minimum of two (02) years of experience in relevant area along with the **discipline specific criteria**. However, the minimum PG qualification would be relaxed to UG qualification (only for B.E/B.Tech background) for candidates having a minimum of five (05) years of experience in total from **Industry/Academic Institutions/Research & Development (R&D) Organisations**. Moreover, while applying, the candidate has to take NOC from the current organization.
