Minutes of the 24th Senate Meeting held on 23rd May, 2022

The 24th meeting of the Senate was held on 23rd May 2022 at 11 am in MDP Centre, ABV-IIITM Gwalior.

Chairman Senate welcomed all the members of senate, special invitees and senate secretary. The item wise minutes of the meeting are as follows:

Item 24.0 IIITM Gwalior

Opening remark and announcement by Chairman Senate, ABV-

- (a) Chairman requested all the member to support the ABV IIITM in making its mission and vision. As this meeting is held after a long time, but there will be regular meeting of senate.
- (b) Honourable members were informed that off-line exams of students except UG 1st year were conducted successfully and results will be declared soon. First year students are going to come to the campus on 1st June 2022 and their classes and examination will be off-line.
- (c) There was no convocation for long time, convocation is planned to have in September/October 2022. All the graduating batch 2022, if successfully completed the requirements, will be getting the degree in upcoming convocation. However, the medallists of 2018 to 2022 passing out batches will be invited to receive the medals in the upcoming convocation.
- (d) There will be academic audit of each program by the external eminent academicians and industrialists. A new academic reform committee (ARC) will be formed to suggest the course curriculum to be implemented from academic session 2023.
- (e) Since institute is entering in 25th year of its establishment, various technical and other activities will be planned.
- (f) Placement of students is excellent. Six students got a package of more than one crore this year.
- (g) As number of faculty and staff member are very less, the selection of new faculty will be carried out soon after approval of BoG regarding the faculty distribution, rosters and advertisements (regular, rolling and SC/ST/OBC special drive)



(h) Five new departments are to be created. PhD admission and ordinance are going to be modified. A separate agenda for these is placed in this meeting.

Resolution:

The senate approved the Modification in PhD Ordinance as proposed

The Senate approved the PhD Assistantship rule as:

The PhD candidate will get the assistantship for a period of 4 years as per GoI norms. In case the candidate is not able to complete the work in 4 years, he/she may be paid 50% of the assistantship without any TA assignment for the 5th year based on the recommendation of a committee duly constituted for the purpose. However, if a candidate requests for the

full assistantship, he/she may be allowed but with TA assignment if a constituted committee recommends. In no case, the assistantship will be paid beyond 5 years.

Item 24.7

Case of Mr. Deepak Bhatnagar admission in M Tech (IS) 2021 Batch

Resolution:

The Senate approved the admission of Mr. Deepak Bhatnagar in M Tech (IS) 2021 Batch from July 2022 as a special case. It should not be taken as a precedence by any other. As he has taken study leave from his employer, institute will not pay M Tech stipend during the program.

Evaluation of M Tech Thesis/B Tech Mini and Major Projects will be done based on the Supervisor's assessment (50% weightage) and major evaluation (50% weightage) done by the panel of experts.

Item 24.11

Registration fees for Summer Semesters

Resolution

The registration fee of Rs. 4000/ per course (Rs 2000 registration fee + Rs 2000/ examination fee) for Summer Semester as proposed is approved by the Senate.

- (a) Maximum period for completing the Program(s)
- (b) Continuation to next year
- (c) Lateral Exit Option

Resolution:

(a) Maximum period for completing the Program(s) - Approved

The maximum time limit to complete the programme(s)like IPG (B Tech – IT+M Tech-IT)/MBA, B Tech, M Tech and MBA is proposed as follows:

- (i) IPG M Tech{B.Tech (IT) + M. Tech (IT)}: 5years + 2 years
- (ii) IPG-M Tech{B.Tech (IT) + MBA}: 5years + 2 years
- (iii) B Tech (CSE): 4 years + 2 years
- (iv) M Tech (all branches): 2 years + 2 years
- (v) MBA /MBA (BA): 2 years + 2 years
- (b) Continuation to next year Approved,

It is proposed that the registration for the 5th semester may be allowed only if the student have cleared all the courses of the I and II semesters, and the registration in 7th semester may be allowed only to those students who have passed the course of I, II, III and IV semesters. This will be applicable w.e.f. 2022 admitted batch.

(c) Lateral Exit Option as proposed - Approved, w.e.f. 2023 passing out batch.

The students of five year IPG program dual degree of B.Tech + M.Tech/MBA will have the option of lateral exit from IPG program after four years with B.Tech degree. Such students have to exercise their choice at the end of third year.

The Senate also approved the branch change for UG students after successfully completing the first year. A rule will be prepared for the 2022 year entry batch.
