## **NOTICE INVITING TENDER**

Sealed tenders for **“Providing and fixing of Fencing on existing boundary wall” of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior,** are invited from the eligible experienced contractors/firms having valid registration with MPPWD/CPWD/ Railways/ MES and the Government Under takings.

### **1. Introduction:**

The Atal Bihari Vajpayee – Indian Institute of Information Technology and Management, Gwalior, invites sealed tenders from experienced contractors for “Providing and fixing of Fencing on existing boundary wall” of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior.’. “The tender documents can be downloaded from the website of the Institute, i.e. ‘www.iiitm.ac.in’.

### **2. Submission of tender form cost and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):**

The Bidder shall furnish the EMD of Rs. 25000.00 (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) along with the tender Online payment in favour of ‘Director, ABV-IIITM, Gwalior’ payable at Gwalior. EMD shall be returned to the unsuccessful bidders after the award of work.

The successful bidder will be required to deposit a performance guarantee in the form of a cash deposit/demand draft/fixed deposit receipt, pledge in the Name of the Director, ABV-IIITM Gwalior, valid for 120 days. EMD of the successful bidder shall be adjusted in the performance guarantee deposit. The performance security will be equal to 5% of the tendered amount. The performance security deposit will be refunded after the completion of the defect liability period and the removal of defects brought to the contractor's notice. The tender not accompanied by the required EMD shall be rejected. No interest will be paid on EMD amount/ performance security deposit.

MSME unit, are exempted for submitting EMD if they produce copy of Registration with MSME, Core MSME Certification must contain the relevant trade, shall be considered for EMD exemption. Selected MSME bidder will have to submit performance security deposit.

If the selected bidder fails to start & execute the work, his EMD will be forfeited as per Government rules.

- a) The offline bids will be received by ABV-IIITM, Gwalior up to /before 01-07-2026 4.00 PM. Any bid received after the prescribed deadline shall not be considered, irrespective of rates. The Technical bids will be opened on the same date at 4.30 pm in the presence of the representatives of the bidders present. The opening date for financial bids of such firms that meet the prescribed technical criteria will be notified separately

- b) The EMD Shall be forfeited if:

The bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity.

- i) In the case of a successful bidder, if he fails to furnish the required performance guarantee

within the specified time limit.

- ii) The EMD of the successful bidder shall be retained adjusted for performance guarantee for the performance of the contract and shall be refundable after expiry of defect liability period.
- iii) The bid shall remain valid for a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of the bid.
- iv) No art work charges will be paid in any case.

### **3. Site Visit:**

The bidder are advised to acquaint himself with the job work, visit the Site & examine site conditions, climatic conditions, labour, power, material availability, transport and communication facilities, environmental regulations, laws and bye- laws of statutory, local bodies and the Govt. of India and collect all information that shall be necessary for preparing the bid and entering into a contract.

The cost of visiting the site and collecting information for the purpose of submission of the bid shall be incurred by the bidder only.

The bidder and any of his personnel or agents will be granted permission by the Institute to enter upon the site for the purpose of such inspection.

### **4. Defect Liability Period:**

The work/ materials of the contractor shall be under 3 months Defect Liability Period (DLP). Any defect(s) noticed during the defect liability period shall be rectified by the contractor without any cost to ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, failing which the Security /Performance guarantee Deposit of the Contractor shall be forfeited. If the contractor backs out from the work tender, the EMD deposited of the contractor shall be forfeited. The contractor may also be debarred from any future tendering process in the institute for reasons assigned hereinabove.

### **5. Detail of required Experience Certificates /Work orders:**

5.1 The Applicant to meet the following minimum Criteria:

- A (1) one similar / civil completed work costing not less than 80% of total tender cost.
- A(2) Two similar /civil completed works costing not less than 60% of total tender cost for each work.
- A (3) Three similar / civil competed works costing not less than 40% of tender cost for each work.
- B Definition of “Similar Work” Experience in carrying out similar work / civil work/ civil maintenance works in private sector or Govt. organizations/ PSU’s.

### **6. Submission of Bids:**

- (a) The sealed hard copy of the tender shall be submitted in one big envelope, super scribing “Providing and fixing of Fencing on existing boundary wall” of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior,’ Two separate sealed envelopes: Envelope ‘A’ containing documents related to the technical bid, EMD and eligibility and Envelope 'B containing. The financial bid should be kept in a big envelope. This envelope and another for "Financial Bid" superscripted as such, addressed to the Registrar, ABV-Indian Institute of Information Technology & Management, Morena Link Road,

- Gwalior – 474015. The sealed tender must be dropped in the tender box placed at Administrative Block, ABV-IIITM Campus Office only, **on or before 01/07/2026 upto ...4.00..... P.M.**
- (b) The technical bid envelope “A” must contain the technical bid in prescribed Performa as per Annexure - I along with online Payment proof of Earnest Money Deposit (refundable but non-interest bearing) of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) favoring ‘Director, ABV-IIITM, Gwalior’, payable at Gwalior, with all relevant documents in support of eligibility and experience criteria. The financial bid envelope must contain only the financial bid. The financial bid shall include all the charges, including all taxes, etc., to complete the work in all respects. ABV-IIITMG will not accept any claim other than those mentioned in the financial bid. The online payment is in favour of as per the details above, but the receipt slips should be enclosed.
  - (c) The technical bid will be opened at the Administrative Block, ABV-IIITM Campus, Gwalior on 01-07-2026. At 4.30 P.M. in the presence of the bidders/ their authorized representatives, and committee members who wish to be present. The Financial bid will be opened on the date that will be communicated to only those bidders who are found to be technically qualified after evaluation of technical bids.
  - (d) The interested firms are advised to read the entire tender document carefully before submitting their tender, and the tender documents not received online in the prescribed form, at and/or are found incomplete in any respect, shall be summarily rejected.
  - (e) Any further clarifications can be sought from the office of the Registrar /Engineering Section, Atal Bihari Vajpayee, Indian Institute of Information Technology and Management, Morena Link Road, Char Shahar Ka Naka, Gwalior – 474015. #### **TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- a. No paper shall be detached from the tender.
- b. If any date mentioned above happens to be a holiday, then the next working day will be the relevant date.
- c. The name and address of the tenderer shall be clearly written in the space provided, and no overwriting, correction, or insertion shall be permitted in any part of the tender unless duly countersigned by the tenderer. The tender shall be filled in and submitted in strict accordance with the instructions laid down herein; otherwise, the tender shall be liable to be rejected by the ABV-IIITMG unilaterally without assigning any reason or giving any explanation to this effect.
- d. The tender shall be liable to be ignored/rejected if complete information is not given therein, or if the particulars and data (if any) asked for in the Schedule to the tender are not filled in or any wrong/false or incorrect information is given, or any material thing is concealed or manipulated therein.
- e. The Earnest Money of the successful tenderer shall be returned after the security deposit as required in terms of the tender is furnished by the L-1. The Earnest Money to other than the lowest bidders will be returned after finalization of the L-1.
- f. The Earnest Money deposited shall be liable to be forfeited if the tenderer withdraws or amends, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of his tender. If the successful tenderer fails to furnish the security deposit as required in the contract within the stipulated period, the EMD shall also be liable to forfeit it and ABV-IIITMG shall be entitled to initiate appropriate legal proceedings against the tenderer for the losses suffered by it because of the same.
- g. All rates/total amount shall include GST (as applicable), cost of labour & material for the works completed in all respects, and no extra amount shall be payable on this account.
- h. Water and Electricity shall be provided free of cost at one point for bona fide use only.

- i. The agency must enclose a copy of the PAN Card of the company/Proprietor / Partner and work experience certificate / work order for having executed similar works. Tenders of any agency without the above shall be rejected outright.
- j. The EMD deposited by the contractor shall be released with the running / final bill duly submitted by the contractor.
- k. The payment shall be made on the submission of a bill, as per actual measurements of works and after successful completion of work by the contractor.
- l. 1. Tender of any agency not adhering to the above-mentioned terms of the tender shall be rejected outright.
- m. A technically qualified bidder will be informed to be present at the time of opening of the financial bid.

### **7. Selection Criteria:**

The work will be awarded to the L1 vendor on an overall basis for the work “ABV-IIITM, GWALIOR”. The determination of the lowest bidder will NOT be based on individual bid rates. Rather, it will be on an overall basis.

The following documents/information shall be attached along with the Technical Bid as follows: -

- a. Copy of Pan Card.
- b. Copy of GST Registration Number.
- c. Last three financial years (up to 31.03.2025), turnover certificate issued by CA, and a copy of three years ITR (AY- 2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26)
- d. EMD – Earnest Money Deposit Proof of payment
- e. Experience Certificates/ Works Orders as mentioned in Clause no.5.
- f. Valid registration with MPPWD/ CPWD/ Govt. Undertaking.
- g. All NIT documents shall be signed by the contractor, partner, or proprietor with a rubber stamp of contractor/ agency and mobile no.
- h. The technical bid page no.11 to13 with online payment of EMD, keep them in envelope no. 1 and seal the envelope properly.
- i. The financial bid should be kept in envelope no.2, and the envelope should be closed properly.
- j. Envelope no.1 & 2 should be kept in envelope no. 3 and closed the envelope properly.
- k. Please write the name of the work, such as “Providing and fixing of Fencing on existing boundary wall” of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior,’ on each envelope.
- l. The other terms and conditions shall be applicable as mentioned in NIT.
- m. The tender of any agency without the above shall be rejected outright.

### **8. Time of Completion**

The work must be started within 3 days of receipt of the W/O. The work shall also be duly completed within 30 Days from the date of receipt of the work order by the agency.

### **9. Liquidated Damages/ Penalty for Delay:**

If the contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated time or time extended by the Institute (if any), liquidated damages at the rate of 0.5% per day (07 days) of delay, subject to a maximum 10% of the total contract value, shall be deducted and recovered from the contractor.

### **10. Specifications:**

The materials supplied and proposed to be used in the work shall be of the requisite specifications as specified in NIT, as per specification given in BOQ and as per the approved list of make (placed at page-08).

The contractor/vendor should have the supplied items/materials certified/verified by a representative authorized by the competent authority of the Institute. In the absence of the same, the material cannot be used on the maintenance site. The vendor should submit the approved sample in the office; substandard items will not be accepted.

**11. Payment:**

Payment will be made after satisfactory completion & handing over of the entire work and bill submitted by the Contractor. Applicable GST/TDS, etc., shall be deducted from the amount payable to the contractor.

**12. Bill of Quantity:**

The quantities of work given in the Bill of Quantities (BOQ) are approximate to give an idea of the work. Work shall be carried out as per the given design/specifications, and the quantities may vary on either side. The contractor shall execute the varied quantity of work on the quoted rates. The payment shall be made as per the actual measurement of work.

**13. Tools & Tackles:**

All tools, tackles, and other equipment required for the work will be provided by the contractor, and their charges will be deemed included in the quoted rates; no extra payment shall be made for the same to the Contractor.

**14. Risks:**

Contractor shall be solely responsible for the safety of his workers, working at the site by following all safety norms in the trade. All risks of loss or damage to physical property and of injury and death which arise during and in consequence of the performance of the Contract, other than the excepted risks, are the responsibility of the Contractor.

**15. Failure:**

Failure of the contractor to comply with the requirements of the contract shall constitute sufficient grounds for cancellation of the award and forfeiture of the EMD, in which event ABV-IIIMG may get the work done at the risk & cost of the Contractor.

**16. Work Order/Contract Agreement:**

ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, will notify the successful bidder that his tender has been accepted, and it will send a LOI/work order to the bidder describing the works to be carried out and the same shall be returned duly acknowledged affirmatively by the bidder as a token of acceptance.

**17. CONCILIATION/ARBITRATION:**

- a. If any dispute (s) or difference (s) of any kind whatsoever arise between the parties, the parties hereto shall negotiate with a view to its amicable resolution and settlement through a committee appointed by the Director, ABV-IIITM, and Gwalior.
- b. In the event no amicable resolution or settlement is reached between the parties within 30 days after receipt of notice by one party, then the disputes or differences detailed above shall be referred to and settled by the sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Director, ABV-IIITM, Gwalior.
- c. The arbitration proceeding shall be in accordance with the prevailing Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and Laws of India as amended or enacted from time to time.

- d. The venue of the arbitration shall be Gwalior, India & the language of the arbitration shall be English. The fee & other charges of the arbitrator shall be determined by the arbitrator in terms of the Act and shall be shared equally between the parties.
- e. The arbitrator shall have powers to award only such remedy as is contemplated by this Agreement, including as appropriate, injunctive relief.
- f. The arbitrator will give the speaking and the reasoned Award. The parties will not be entitled to any pendent-lite interest during arbitration proceedings.

18. Tender shall be accompanied by all the relevant documents covered in the tender.

19. The full & final payment shall be made by the Institute only after the successful completion of work/items for which the bid is made.

20. The contractor/supplier shall ensure that he himself or his authorised representative is available for proper handing over of the supplies/consignments at ABV-IIITM Campus, Gwalior.

21. All statutory duties and taxes / GST and any other taxes or duties may be clearly specified. Price quoted shall be firm and any variation in rates, prices or terms during the validity of the offer shall attract the forfeiture of the EMD and shall entitle ABV-IIITM to take appropriate legal action against the Tenderer.

22. The contractor shall be liable with regard to compliance of all laws, regulations, rules & directions given by any statutory or constitutional authority for the time being in force in the Gwalior City.

**23. Right to accept or reject the Tender:**

Director, ABV-IIITM, Gwalior reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

**24. Scope of the work.**

- 1. Carefully remove existing damaged or loose fencing without causing any damage to the stone boundary wall supporting structure.
- 2. Carry out drilling of holes, or welding with another member using suitable equipment for fixing of “Y” posts for holding concertina wire with proper alignment, spacing, and required embedment.
- 3. Re-fix, align, and secure stone boulders where required in proper line and level.
- 4. Finishing matching with the existing work.
- 5. Ensure all safety precautions during execution, including scaffolding, barricading, and protection of nearby areas.
- 6. Inspect the site thoroughly and identify all loose, damaged, or unsafe stone boulders, fencing requiring repair
- 7. Clean the work site after completion and dispose of all debris and waste materials as per directions of the Engineer-in-Charge.
- 8. Use 50 mm X 50 mm x 5 mm MS section for making of “Y” Posts each post shall be 3 M c/c, primer shall be for painting of “Y” posts standard brands only.
- 9. All the technical specification should be followed as mention in the BOQ , IS CODE, CPWD Norms
- 10. The work should be complete within stipulated time Materials of good quality like Cement, Sand, Aggregate, steel, admixture, welding rod etc. Should be used only of standard/reputed brands, with following of Indian standard codes, conditions and other relevant specification.
- 11. All work should be carried out as per Indian standard/specification with following, direction of

- engineer in charge.
12. Technical/ skilled manpower shall be used in construction.
  13. Safety equipment should be used thoroughly, no separate payment will be made for the same.
  14. After completion of work the vendor are responsible to cleaning and removing debris or other unwanted material.
  15. Time allowed for completion of work: one month / as per area of the ground from the date of receiving the Work order.
  16. Quantity may vary from the quantity mentioned in the list.

  18. The safety of manpower should be proper and adequate which must be taken care by contractor/vendor only.
  19. Work will be execute as per specification of CPWD and the measurement should be recorded as per specification of CPWD.
  20. The work order will be issued on the requirement basis of the institute.

**Special conditions of contract for the work of “Providing and fixing of Fencing on existing boundary wall” of ABV-IIITM, Gwalior, ’**

- 1- The contractor will have to provide all safety tools and tackles to workers engaged by him on the site.
- 2- The Contractor firm /individual will be fully responsible for any sort of mishappening/accident at the site, and the Institute will be fully relieved of any liability.
- 3- The Contractor will keep the labour disciplined at the site.
- 4- Mechanical means will be used to the maximum extent for work operations.
- 5- Concertina wire and barbed wire shall be ISI approved brand.
- 6- All the material shall be of standard reputed brands.
- 7- - Quantity may reduce or increase during execution as per the site.
- 9- The first and final bill is to be paid only after completion of the work to the satisfaction.
  
- 10- The estimated measurement of repair work in proposed work is given merely as a rough guide. The quantity and items mentioned in the schedule may therefore vary, which will have to be accepted by the contractor in the offered rates. The payments shall be made to the agency as per actual measurement of work executed at site.
- 11- The payment shall be made to the contractor on satisfactory completion of the work and the contractor shall prepare computerized bills as per prescribed format of Tax invoices.
- 12- Before using the material, the contractor shall get approval from the Institute and any changes to the work will require approval from the Institute.
- 13- After communication regarding award of work, the successful bidder shall, within 3 days, submit a non-judicial stamp of Rs. 100/- and sign an agreement with the Institute for the work, on the terms & conditions of the present tender.
  
- 14- EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after three one of the date of final bill.
- 15- The bidders shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions given in the tender document underprice bid, inclusive of all taxes, appropriate materials, labor, machinery, machines tools and plants and all appliances whatsoever are necessary for the complete execution of the work. Nothing extra shall be paid by Institute other than those quoted in the financial bid, if scope of extra/lead or contingency work is not approved by the Director of the Institute.
- 16- All the required labor will be arranged by the contractor only and no minor shall be engaged at site. For all intents and purposes, the unskilled labor and such-like personnel provided by the contractor shall be the employees of the contractor and ABV-IIITM shall not own any responsibility in any manner whatsoever for the same.
- 17- The competent authority of the Institute reserves right to accept the whole or any part of the tender and the contractor shall be bound to perform the same at the quoted rates.
- 18- The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **120 days**.
- 19- The work shall be completed within **30 days** from the date of agreement and intimation regarding commencement of work will be made by the contractor to the Institute.
- 20- **A penalty @ 0.5% per week will be imposed for delay**, which shall be deducted from the bill of the contractor and the penalty so imposed **shall not exceed 10%** of the total cost. If any hurdle arises, the same may be intimated to the office of competent authority and accordingly, extension of time-period shall be made, if required.
- 21- The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specifications and CPWD Works Manual up to the entire satisfaction of the Institute.
- 22- No waste/ debris of any sort including dismantled material, including dismantled material, will be left at the work site or anywhere in the Institute campus and the contractor shall be responsible to remove and dispose it outside the campus at their own cost.

- 23- The contractor will be fully responsible for any type of loss to the Institute property during execution of work. If any damage is caused at the site or surroundings, the same shall be made good within the quoted rates without any additional payments on this account.
- 24- The contractor shall raise the Bill as per actual work carried-out at site. Any item of work exceeding the quantity specified in this tender document shall require prior written permission of the Institute. The payment shall be made to the contractor on receipt of bills in duplicate and upon satisfaction of the Institute with respect to the entire work.
- 25- Debarred/blacklisted agency/firm/ individual shall not be permitted to participate in the tendering process.
- 26- The sub-contracting shall not be allowed.
- 27- If the contractor fails to complete the work as per work order up to the satisfaction of the Institute, or commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of contract, then the Institute shall have right to forfeit EMD and/or performance security / guarantee, as the case may be. In addition, the Institute shall have the right to blacklist the contractor.
- 28- The contractor will not be entitled for any compensation due to enactment of any law / regulation etc. during the currency of the contract.
- 29- All Taxes on materials or any element of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and the Institute will not entertain any such claim whatsoever in this respect. The contractor's rates shall cater to all such taxes.
- 30- **The Institute will deduct income tax and any other tax applicable, at source from all the payments made to the contractor under this contract, in accordance with the provisions of IT Act or any other law as applicable from time to time.**
- 31- The contractor shall be fully responsible to observe the labor safety provisions and all risks of loss of or damage to physical and personal loss and death which arise during the execution of work shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 32- Action in case of bad work - If it shall appear to that any work has been executed with unsound, imperfect or unskillful workmanship or with materials of any inferior description the Institute may rectify and re-execute the work or remove and replace with others, material or articles complained of as the case maybe at the risk and expense in all respects of the contractor.
- 33- Criteria for work award will ordinarily be the aggregated lowest rates quoted for all the items.
- 34- The Institute reserves the right to ask the justification of quoted rates before award of work.
- 35- The contractor has to follow all electricity rules as amended from time to time and contractor shall be responsible for any mishap due to negligence on his/labor part whatsoever.
- 36- Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the bidders, who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
- 37- The agency will submit in writing to the Institute after complete work is executed and finished.
- 38- All risks of loss of or damage to physical property and of personal injury and death which arise during and in consequence of the performance of the Contract are the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 39- In the event of any dispute between the Institute and contractor, it shall be resolved through mutual discussions between the parties. If it cannot be resolved through discussion.
- 40- Water and power for bonafide use will be available and contractor will have to take metered connection and will have to pay charges for the same.
- 41- Gwalior District will be judicial jurisdiction for all disputes.
