

VIRTUAL REALITY IN FILMMAKING

Filmmaking in VR is different not just because of the content or the experience, but also because of the process. The fundamental basis of writing, filming, creating visual effects, and working with sound is shifting to being viewer-centric.

Without ever setting foot on the set or being in a single meeting, every step of the creative process you have to ask what the viewer is doing, seeing, feeling and thinking, and react to that ..

There's suddently no 'behind the camera', the set is all around you, and there's nowhere to put your crew, your lights, your boom operator. Your camera is your viewer. Imagine what that does to, for example, the lighting, or production design.


People say that VR is inherently more exciting than traditional film. But we shouldn't think film and VR are somehow competing for the same attention. It's not either-or, it's both.

VR film Directors have to make sure that the luxury of choice doesn't kill the story. The biggest challenge faced in VR filmmaking is how to future proof the work. If you're shooting a film on a GoPro 3 or 4, and reducing that footage down to 4k because otherwise your hardware can't keep up. But even 4k footage isn't really all that high-res when it's stretched 360 degrees around you.


Although a lot of the equipment such as rigs, light stands and higher quality cameras have been developed filmakers face a lot of trial and error. The only limits lie in the adaptability of your technical and engineering prowess or your threshold for general squeamishness.



DID YOU KNOW?

Microsoft had plans for its own version of the Macbook Touch Bar - 15 years ago. Apple unveiled its new Macbook Pro featuring a slick OLED-powered keyboard display called Touch Bar on October 28, 2016. The concept for 'adaptive hardware' as Microsoft dubbed it, was initially born in 1999 with the intent to build responsive action keys that show and hide parts of the keyboard based on context. They experimented with keyboard technology that changed the function keys and actions according to the applications you run. Microsoft's foray into adaptive hardware came to a halt in 2009 with a piece of tech which it called "Adaptive Keyboard". It featured a programmable display top as well as

a large display area above the keys.

Microsoft ultimately opted not to move forward with developing products based on the adaptive keyboard technology because they didn't build computers back then. But when they eventually got into putting together computers, they chose to build devices with touch screens instead while Apple took the other path.







INTERNET OF THINGS

The agenda here is let to your gadgets talk with each other and make your life easier. Previously you had to control gadgets, now let them share information and control themselves. The information shared, can also stimulate the business processes. IoT services stand on three pillars, namely, 'sensors-the sensory organs to our digital devices', 'connectivity - a necessity to circulate the data in the network' and 'the 'process' - task of taking decisions for the sake of 'people'. But the challenge is these 'smart objects' need to interact over the Internet, query and change their state, taking into account security and privacy issues and not keeping the confidentiality at stake.

VIRTUAL REALITY

We know the world through our perception system, consisting of five senses. The truth is that humans have many more senses, which can be simply stimulated by the state of mind. For example, the sense of balance. VR exploits this fact by presenting your senses with a computer generated virtual environment. And since you present your senses with made up information, your perception of reality also changes, in response to it. You would be presented with an environment that is not really there, but you assume it as real. With the giants like Amazon and google already into it, it definitely is a future tech.



WEB 3.0

WEB 3.0 is simply the more intelligent web. Gallop to the era of "phrases" from that of "keywords". Present your web 3.0 browser with a complex search and it utilizing its features like, extensive connectivity, distributed databases, machine learning, natural language processing, autonomous agents, can present you with a very precise results. For example, you could just type "I want to see a funny movie and then eat at a good Mexican restaurant. What are my options?" Instead of splitting your search into that for a 'funny movie', a restaurant with 'Mexican meals'. The Web 3.0 browser will analyze your response, search the Internet for all possible answers, and then organize the results for you. This "intelligent web" keeps on learning and the responses improve and become more user-specific over the time, as you keep using it.

DEEP LEARNING For the past three centuries humans have

been making machines, it's now turn to make

intelligent machines. Let the machines learn while they function and thus even perform better. A combination of classical probability and latest algorithms, deep learning is one of the future techs. An algorithm is deep if the input is passed through several non-linearities before being output. It utilizes the concept of ANN (Artificial Neural Networks), inspired by the biological neural networks. The ANN are presented as systems of interconnected "neurons" which exchange messages between each other, have connection weights and can be tuned with experience, making them capable of learning. Years back, NN were only 2 layers deep, but now it is computationally possible to have NN 10+ layers deep. Most modern learning algorithms are shallow.

STARTUP INDIA

Startup India Campaign is based on an action plan aimed at promoting bank financing for start-up ventures to boost entrepreneurship and encourage start ups with jobs creation. It is focused on to restrict role of States in policy domain and to get rid of "license raj" and hindrances like in land permissions, foreign investment proposal, environmental clearances. A startup is an entity that is headquartered in India which was opened less than five years ago and has an annual turnover less than ₹25 crore. The Standup India initiative is also aimed at promoting entrepreneurship among SCs/STs, women communities.

Some key points to be noted in this campaign are:

- 1. Single Window Clearance even with the help of a mobile application.
- 2. 10,000 crore fund of funds.
- 3. 80% reduction in patent registration fee.
- 4. Modified and more friendly Bankruptcy Code to ensure 90-day exit window.
- 5. Freedom from mystifying inspections for 3 years.
- 6. Freedom from Capital Gain Tax for 3 years.
- 7. Freedom from tax in profits for 3 years.
- 8. Self-certification compliance.
- 9. Starting with 5 lakh schools to target 10 lakh children for innovation programme.
- 10. new schemes to provide IPR protection to start-ups and new firms.
- 11. Stand India across the world as a start-up hub.

The campaign brought about investments from companies around the globe. SoftBank, which is headquartered in Japan, has invested US\$2 billion into Indian startups. The Japanese firm had pledged the total investments at US\$10 billion. Google declared to launch a startup, based on the highest votes in which the top three startups will be allowed to join the next Google Launchpad Week, and the final winner could win an amount of US\$100,000 in Google cloud credits. Oracle on 12 February 2016 announced to set up nine incubation centres in Bengaluru, Chennai, Gurgaon, Hyderabad, Mumbai, Noida, Pune, Trivandrum and Vijayawada. The Ministry of Human Resource Development and the Department of Science and Technology have agreed to partner in an initiative to set

up over 75 such startup support hubs in the National Institutes of Technology (NITs), the Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs), the Indian Institutes of Science Education Research (IISERs) and National Institutes Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPERs).







