Advertisement for M.Tech. (GATE/Non-GATE) Odd Sem Admissions-2026

ABV-IIITM Gwalior invites applications for the M.Tech. (GATE/Non-GATE) odd semester admission-2026 (other than CCMT) at institute level in the following courses and departments:

1. **M.Tech (Computer Science and Engineering) and M.Tech (Information and Cyber Security), offered by the Department of Computer Science and Engineering.**
2. **M.Tech (Information Technology) and M.Tech (Wireless Networks and Computing), offered by the Department of Information Technology.**
3. **M.Tech (IC Design and Technology) and M.Tech (Autonomous Systems and Machine Intelligence), offered by the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering.**

The admission is against the seats vacant/supernumerary (if any) after M.Tech. odd semester -2026 (CCMT) admission. The primary objective of these specialized programs is to equip students with the skills needed to address real-world challenges in various industrial sectors and foster academic excellence by encouraging research in their respective fields. Our newly designed M.Tech. curricula offer students a broader and more immersive learning experience. This includes access to advanced laboratories and engaging research projects, ensuring a comprehensive education in their chosen areas of expertise.

A. Important Guidelines for the M.Tech. Application

- The applicants must apply through only online, i.e., Google form (application) available at <https://forms.gle/HXS5UNWRQr4n7NQU6>
- There is **NO application fee**.
- Applicants with Valid GATE qualifying score will be provided stipend/scholarship as per Institute rule.
- **Applicants without a valid GATE qualifying score shall not be eligible for any institute stipend or scholarship. However, if a faculty member wishes to engage such a student as a Teaching Assistant (TA) or Research Assistant (RA), financial support may be provided from the faculty member's sponsored research project or other available research funds, subject to the applicable project and institute rules.**
- The first priority for admission will be given to applicants with Valid GATE qualifying score and rank. Applicants without Valid GATE qualifying score have to appear in written exam (MCQ) and admission will be given based on written exam performance and previous academic records against vacant/ supernumerary (if any) seats. The written test will be based on the syllabus related to GATE CS & IT, GATE EC and elementary mathematics. There will be a single question paper for all candidates, irrespective of their department/program of application, consisting of questions covering the syllabus of GATE CS & IT, GATE EC, and elementary mathematics.
- If two students have the same GATE score then priority will be decided as per the criteria mentioned on the CCMT website (<https://ccmt.admissions.nic.in/>).
- Candidates must bring a copy of their academic credentials, a valid GATE qualifying score card (if any), category certificate (if applicable), at the time of counselling and admission. Originals of all the above documents are required at the time of document verification. Failing which the candidate may not be allowed for the M.Tech admission process.
- Candidates need to bring four (04) passport size photographs at the time of written test, counselling

and admission.

- Seats are reserved for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)/Other Backward Class Non-Creamy Layer (OBC-NCL)/Schedule Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST), and Person with Benchmark Disability (PwD) categories as per Government of India norms.
- Appearing for M.Tech admission-2026 does not guarantee that the candidate will get the admission. It is based on the availability of the vacant/supernumerary (if any) seats after the regular admissions through CCMT (M.Tech. summer admission-2026), and full filling the eligibility and selection criteria.
- During the admission, document verification (GATE and Non-Gate) and written exam (Non-Gate candidates) will take place.
- Physically attending the admission-2026 process is mandatory for all applicants. No admission can be offered to any candidate in a virtual mode.
- There will be no acknowledgment/confirmation provided on filling out the online form. There is no screening. All Non-Gate applicants must directly report to **Room 106, Lecture Theatre I (LT-I), ABV-IIITM Gwalior at 10:00 AM sharp, August 8, 2026.**
- Limited accommodation may be available for out-station on payment basis to participate in the M.Tech. admission. The current tariff for a room at the Visitor Hostel is available at https://iiitm.ac.in/public/uploads/media_uploads/1770215155_Visitor-Hostel-Booking-Form.pdf. For reservation, please send an email to visitorhostel@iiitm.ac.in.
- The applicants are requested to check the institute website regularly for updates.
- Institute has right the to fill or not fill the seats. Candidates may note that seats other than the vacant seats (after CCMT counselling) may also be available during seat allotment process due to upgradation/withdrawal of existing allottees.

C. Eligibility

- Admission to different M.Tech. programs will be governed by the rules and eligibility criteria of the institute.
- Different M.Tech. programs consider selected preceding degrees/branches and GATE papers (if applicable) for admissions. Details of qualifying criteria are available at https://drive.google.com/file/d/1xh0g1-O_ayu6qtAJ6a2vE0i-gT-BWTaJ/view?usp=sharing
- Candidate without valid GATE score is also eligible.
- The following are the **special eligibilities/restrictions** for admission to the above programmes.
 - Candidates should have minimum 60% marks (or CGPA 6.5 on a 10-point scale) for Gen/EWS/OBC-NCL whereas 55% marks (or CGPA 6.0 on a 10-point scale) for SC/ST/PwD in the qualifying degree aggregate of all semesters/years.
 - Candidates should have passed Mathematics in 10+2 level.
 - If qualifying degree result is awaited, candidate should have minimum 60% marks (or CGPA 6.5/10) till pre-final semester and NO existing backlog papers.

D. Admission Process Details:

- All the non-gate applicants must physically report to the administrative building, ABV-IIITM Gwalior at 10:00 AM sharp, August 08, 2026 for the written test.
- Based on the valid GATE qualifying score, written exam performance and previous academic records (Non-GATE), a common merit list of all the Gate/Non-Gate candidates will be displayed on the institute website on 10th August 2026.
- Based on the common merit list and the number of seats available, the committee will recommend suitable candidates for admission on 13th August 2026. It is recommended to come with the demand draft of the fees on the day of the counselling.
- Selected candidates must pay the fee on the same day in form of demand draft to reserve the seat.

E. Special Provisions for M.Tech. students

- The M.Tech students are also eligible to continue to the Ph.D. programme based on eligibility and norms of the institute.
- The selected candidates (valid GATE qualifying score) admitted to the M.Tech. programme shall be entitled for fellowship as per the GoI norms.
