- b. The candidates are required fill an online application using the provided link of google form / or by scanning the QR Code on the institute website.
- c. There is no Application fee for the programme.
- d. The candidate applying under application category B are required to report at institute on 08.08.2026 at 09:30 AM sharp at MDP Center for the interview process.
- e. The candidate applying under application category C are required to report at institute on 08.08.2026 at 09:30 AM sharp at MDP Center for the aptitude test. The indicative syllabus for the aptitude test are as follows:
 - i. **Indicative Syllabus:** The Department may conduct a Aptitude Test comprising of

- quantitative aptitude, logical thinking, verbal ability, and problem-solving skills.
- ii. There may be 25 objective type multiple choice questions in the Test paper, each of them carries 04 marks for right answers. The total maximum marks for the Aptitude test will be 100 marks.
- f. Candidates appearing for the final year of bachelor's degree and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results can also apply. However, such candidates, if selected, are required to submit the degree certificate before registration for the programme. Failing which their admission shall stand cancelled.
- g. A relaxation of marks or equivalent in CGPA for the SC / ST / PwD candidates are as per GoI Norms
